Tournament Rules

1. This is a scramble 9-hole event. This means everyone has the chance to contribute on each shot - you will take the best ball hit by a member of your foursome. There is no requirement to take at least one tee shot from each member of your group.
2. This tournament is a “shot gun” start - meaning all groups will tee off at 4 p.m. In some cases, two groups of four will start at same holes. You will be assigned a hole when you register your team. Group A will tee off first, followed by Group B once the lead group is out of range of your tee shot.
3. Please do your best to keep moving on the course. This is a large tournament for a 9-hole course, and it is important that we don't get backed up. If you lose a ball in a rough area, please don't spend a lot of time looking for it. It doesn't take much to delay the flow of golfers moving from one hole to the next.
4. Please make sure someone in your group has a scorecard. At the end of your 9-holes you will have to hand in your card to the tournament organizers.
5. The best score on the course doesn't necessarily mean you will win the tournament. After handing in your score card, you will also pick a number that will either be added or subtracted from your score. The range is -2 to +2.
6. The 2nd hole is designated as the “Closest to the Hole Competition”. The woman & man who put their tee shot closest to the pin will win a special prize.
7. The 8th hole is designated as the “Longest Drive” hole. The woman and man who hit their tee shot the furthest win a special prize.
8. Get the best poker hand and win special prizes for your team. When you arrive back at the Club House after your game, you will choose your poker hand. The team with the best poker hand wins!
9. We will be raffling off some special prizes after dinner. All money raised through this raffle will support students in financial need. We hope you will support this wonderful cause.
10. When you get back into the Club House we will start cooking our steak. We will all be eating together when everyone is done playing. Dinner should be around 7:30 p.m.
