



Algonquin College offers a unique program geared towards individuals interested in becoming a General Machinist Apprentice.

Starting August 9th, 2010 qualified applicants with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) will be given the opportunity to start a General Machinist Pre-Apprenticeship Training program. The goal of this program is to prepare participants to successfully enter a full apprenticeship program. Upon starting the trade specific training, the successful candidates will be signed as apprentices by the Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities. The program is designed in such a way that even if an individual chooses not to pursue the apprenticeship route they can easily transfer into post secondary programs at an intermediate level.
